

"The Flåm Railway is an experience unparalleled in Europe"

As one of Norway's few private railways, Flåmsbana offers a journey through the best of Western Norway's beautiful, untouched and dramatic nature.

The journey from Flåm in the innermost part of the Aurlandsfjord, up to Myrdal mountain station at 867 masl., is a railway experience unparalleled in Europe! From the comfort of a vintage train compartment, you can enjoy the changing scenery of the steep and narrow Flåm Valley. The sparkling blue river follows the railway for large parts of the trip, passing through agricultural landscapes where you'd think no one could live, the old Flåm village centre and the old church.

The journey, with views of mighty waterfalls and mountain peaks, takes about 60 minutes. The train travels slowly and takes a five-minute photo stop at the Kjosfossen waterfall where you can go out onto the platform. The train connect at Myrdal with most day-trains between the capital city of Oslo and Bergen on the west coast.






Amazing feat of engineering

Construction of the railway lasted from 1923 to 1940 and is said to be one of the greatest engineering feats in Norway. The 20 km long railway line is one of the steepest standard gauge lines in the world, with 80% of the journey running on a gradient of 5.5%. There are no less than 20 tunnels, 18 of which were built by hand. One of the tunnels even takes a 180 degree turn inside the mountain.

The train runs alongside a construction road, known as the Rallar Road or Navvies' Road, that was built to transport materials from the fjord to the mountains when the Bergen Line was built around 1900. Today, the Rallar Road is a popular cycling route from Finse to Flåm.

Famous worldwide

The National Geographic Traveler Magazine calls the Flåm Railway one of the top 10 train journeys in Europe while in 2014, Lonely Planet went even further and called it the best train journey in the world. It is a true bucket list experience when visiting Norway, and by far one of the most popular tourist attractions.



Agent reservations for The Flåm Railway

Agent bookings for both individuals and groups, using our net rates, must be made separately. We recommend requesting an agent login to our booking site, Citybreak Sales Agent System, at www.agent.citybreak.com

We recommend making reservations well in advance, as some departures may be fully booked. We recommend "Group Bookings" for organized groups of 10 people or more to gain assigned seating with the group's name on the train windows. When making a reservation it is important to inform about the nationality, which enables us to provide correct guiding onboard, both visually and by audio. Any major changes in the number of travellers or possible cancellations must be reported as early as possible.

Individual reservations

The Flåm Railway and the Vy Oslo-Bergen Railway are cooperating on the same ticket system, which gives an opportunity to have a common and a general one-way train ticket for individuals (FITs) covering both lines.

Entur operates ticket system, customer centre and the stations' sales and service on behalf of the railway companies operating on the Norwegian rail network.

Combined and coordinated travels

Tickets for the Flåm Railway, solely or combined with the Bergen line, may be purchased at all manned stations, on Enturs ticket machines, at www.vy.no, or on the spot in our premises in Flåm Visitor Centre & Train Station.


Requirements: Even though most of the trail is downhill, the hike is described as demanding due to length and rocky path. Some hiking experience and good physical shape is recommended.



About the hike

The walk from Østerbø to Vassbygdi is about 20 kilometres long and takes approximately 6-8 hours. The path is easy to find and marked with the red T-signs. It is possible to hike the opposite way.

In the early season, there might be rockfalls and remnants of landslides on the way, as well as high water level. We recommend to always check the conditions and be prepared for changing conditions, as the weather can be unpredictable.

The Flåm Railway Museum offers an authentic El-9 locomotive, an old electric range locomotive, several rail tricycle and exhibitions with text, pictures, sounds and objects, as well as video presentation of a journey on the Flåm Railway. In front of the museum, you will find a shop with Flåm Railway logo items and souvenirs. You can for example buy books and videos about Flåm and the Flåm Railway and the shop do carry the traditional Aurland Shoe.





Food philosophy

Good food and drinks are important parts of a successful stay. 'Norwegian', 'locally produced' and 'in season' are the basics of Fretheim Hotel's food concept. You will not only get a tasty meal. Cultural history is a part of the package, and you are participating to local economic growth just by dining.

Our menus are seasonal and based on traditions with a modern touch, prepared with first-class ingredients that are as short-distance as possible. - We believe that it is more sustainable to offer hand-picked blueberries from a local farmer, than organic blueberries which must be shipped in from California, says Head Chef Bjarte Finne.

It is not only the food that is locally produced.

Juice and cider from the Sognefjord and the Hardangerfjord have become popular. Beer brewing has long traditions in Western Norway and we serve beer from the local brewery in Flåm.





Short travelled


'Short travelled' is one of the basic principles in our food philosophy. Both sustainability and animal welfare is central, and we work closely with a number of local producers who share our values. Try goat cheese from Undredal, cured meats from Haugen Gardsmat, fresh vegetables from Sogn, berries from Lærdal and meat from Tveite Gard. We are part of the network Smak av Kysten (Taste of the coast) and among other things, we get halibut from a land-based fish farm by the Sognefjord and shellfish from the coast outside Bergen.

We want to contribute to a vibrant local culture and biological diversity in the world heritage area. When we support local producers, they can focus on operating on a scale appropriate to the area.

Produce in season

We base our menus on the season and traditional cooking methods. Autumn is the time for mountain-grazed lambs, game, root vegetables, and apples. Perfect for chilly evenings! In winter, fish and shellfish are at their best, accompanied by root vegetables. Food was traditionally cured, smoked and canned to last through winter, methods you will find on our menu.

In spring, life starts to germinate and grow. Spring vegetables, such as asparagus and fresh herbs, are central. Summer is time for fresh vegetables, berries and fruits here by the fjord.

Oscarsborg fortress

Due to the island's place in the narrowest part of the Oslofjord, it was a natural location for a naval defence of Oslo. The first defence was constructed as early as the mid 17th century, while the fortress which stands today was finished in 1853. The fortress is best known for sinking Nazi-Germany's heavy cruiser Blücher, on the morning of 9th April 1940. The last military operations ended in 2002 and the island and fortress now function as museum and hotel open for visitors.






